## The Carmelite Corner

### THE FOURTH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

**READINGS:**

**JAS 1:17-21**

**JN 16:5-14**

**V.** Praised be Jesus Christ... **R.** Now and forever!

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, we continued the renewed energy of joy from last week, basking in the glory of that first Easter morning. The Introit [opening song] from Psalm 97 underscores the newness of creation in the resurrection of Jesus – we are encouraged to glorify the wondrous things He has accomplished by means of our newness of attitude and song. If salt loses its flavor, what use is it [cf. MT 5:13]. We who are Christians should be recognized by the “flavor” of our joy, in front of all of humanity, particularly to those who are not believers. We must glorify the risen Christ by our very lives, and in all situations.

The Epistle of today shifts to James. We are reminded that God is the Father of light – there is no darkness in the lives of those who walk in the light of Jesus Christ as “word” [cf. JN 1:1] and “truth” [cf. JN 14:6]. Christ is the first of many brothers and sisters under the Father. James cautions the Christian to be different from others in the world, which is replete with noise and hostility. We should listen more than we speak – this gets us to hear the Master’s voice better; and anger is a powerful negative emotion – and anything that is negative is contrary to the fulfillment of the righteousness of God.

The Gospel of today sees Jesus continuing to prepare the apostles for His impending return to the Father. The separation causes sorrow for them, but Jesus points to the good of the fulfillment of the manifestation of the Trinity, when the Advocate comes and empowers them for ministry. Jesus tells them that the “prince of this world [the devil] is already judged,” and they shall be kept strong in the faith against the wiles of this “prince,” by the overwhelming truth that the Spirit will impart to them.

Carmelite prayer can never be simply a routine appointment that we make with God – it is so much more than that because of the action of the Holy Spirit in our lives. The Spirit of God who knows the depths of God indwells us, speaking in the heart of each one of us, giving us knowledge of God. We respond through an ever-growing sense of the presence of God and an increasing acceptance of the action of God in our own lives, and in the whole of creation [cf. LK 1:34-37].

To Jesus Christ be all glory, alleluia!

# April is Organ Donation Awareness Month

I might be a bit late in writing this, but I think it is an important message. One of the first things I did after being asked to be the Chaplain for St. John's Knights of Columbus was do celebrate the vigil of a brother Knight and parishioner who died of kidney failure. This was very personal to me; not because I knew the man, but because I also have End Stage Renal Failure. This past week, members of the Knights of Columbus received an email from the New Jersey State Deputy asking for prayers for a State Officer who is in need of a kidney.

Currently there are about 125,000 people in the United States waiting for an organ transplant: heart, lung, liver or kidney. Over 100,000 of them are waiting for a kidney transplant, like I am. It is the most needed organ for transplant. Yet less than 20,000 kidney transplants will be performed each year. About 13 people die every day waiting for a kidney. I have been told that I will probably need to wait 5-7 years before they find me a kidney.

First, I would like to encourage all of you to register to be an organ donor. You can register online at [www.donatelife-nj.org](http://www.donatelife-nj.org). This means that when you die, your organs will be given to people who need them. One person can save up to 8 lives through organ donation.

Second, you could consider becoming a living organ donor. Kidney donation is a remarkable act of compassion that can significantly improve the quality of life for someone living with kidney disease. If you're considering becoming a living kidney donor, here are some essential guidelines to consider:

## Eligibility Criteria

- **Age:** You must be 18 years or older at all transplant centers. Some centers may require donors to be 21 or slightly older.
- **Health:** To be a living kidney donor, you must:
  - Have two healthy, functioning kidneys.
  - Be healthy enough to undergo the donation process.
- **Health Evaluation:** You'll need to undergo a comprehensive health evaluation at the transplant center. The donor evaluation team will assess your physical and emotional readiness to donate. The evaluation includes various tests and exams, such as:
  - Blood and tissue type tests
  - Urine tests
  - Heart and lung assessments
  - Blood pressure checks
  - Imaging (such as a spiral CT scan) of your kidneys
  - Additional screenings based on your age and gender (e.g., colonoscopy, mammogram, prostate exam, Pap smear).
  - A social worker will also evaluate your mental and emotional preparedness for donation and assess your support system.
- **Types of Living Donation**
  - Directed Donation: You choose a specific person with kidney disease (such as a family member or friend) to donate your kidney to.
  - Non-directed Donation: You donate your kidney to a stranger, often through a paired kidney exchange program.

Remember that becoming a living kidney donor is a significant decision. If you meet the criteria and choose to proceed, your selfless act could profoundly impact someone's life. If you are interested in becoming a living donor, contact the NJ Sharing Network at: <https://www.njsharingnetwork.org>
