

A Note From Our Pastor

Very Rev. Michael Wallack

My Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. How can we know God? Jesus revealed to His disciples the great mystery of our Faith - the triune nature of God and the inseparable union of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Jesus' mission is to reveal the glory of God to us - a Trinity of persons - God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - and to unite us with God in a community of love. The ultimate end, the purpose for which God created us, is the entry of God's creatures into the perfect unity of the blessed Trinity.

Pope Benedict XVI's first encyclical was entitled, "God Is Love" (1 John 4:8). It's something we have all heard many times. In fact, we may have become so used to it that we don't remember how revolutionary and unique that conception of God really is. There are many religions in the world, and many of them have come to understand that God is good. But almost all of them start with man's search for God. And because human nature is limited, that search can only arrive to a limited view of God.

Christianity is different. Christianity is about God's search for man. When Jesus Christ came to earth, He came in order to rescue the fallen human race from evil and bring it to the joys of eternal life. And so, in Christianity, we have the privilege of receiving God's own revelation of Himself - He actually shows us, in Christ, who He is and what He is like. And His most fundamental and essential characteristic is love. Not power, not knowledge, not transcendence - but love.

We also celebrate Father's Day this Sunday and we pray for their holiness as well. Many of us have had the pleasure of learning the Faith from the example of our Fathers. We remember all of our Fathers, both with us and those who have gone before us into eternal life. Bishop O'Connell once wrote in a homily on family life, "The family is the central unit of human society and of the Church, a symbol of and witness to the love with which our Lord Jesus Christ loves His Church. Consecrated by the Sacrament of Matrimony, husbands and wives share their vocation and path to holiness in the families they are graced and blessed by God to create and raise."

May God bless all of our Fathers with peace and joy this Father's Day.

Our online program will be offered to students in Grades 1 and in Grades 3 through 8.


Registration

Lunch Convivium Schedule





OHF John of the Cross



It was around the year 415 and St. Augustine, Bishop of Hippo [in North Africa, present-day Algeria] was walking along the beach, having taken a break from working on what has become known as one of his greatest doctrinal contributions to the Church, *De Trinitate*, or "On the Trinity." He came upon a freckle-faced child, clearly up to something, running back-and-forth between the sea and a tiny hole in the ground.

"My son," St. Augustine called over the crashing waves, "What are you doing there?"

The boy held up the pink shell he was using to move water, "I'm trying to fit that great big ocean into this

tiny hole," he yelled, pointing assertively at the sand.

Augustine smiled at the child's innocence, and he then followed the boy to kneel beside the tiny hole, watching him spill out a few meager drops.

Augustine turned the boy to face the sea, and broke the news gently, while spreading his arms wide, he said, "You could never fit this great, magnificent ocean into that tiny hole!"

The child did not flinch, but responded quickly: "And you could never possibly understand the Holy Trinity." Then in a flash, the boy disappeared...

Let us allow this prayer stand on its own merit - read and ponder - how a Carmelite views the Trinity...

"O my God, Trinity whom I adore, let me entirely forget myself that I may abide in You, still and peaceful as if my soul were already in eternity; let nothing disturb my peace nor separate me from You, O my unchanging God, but that each moment may take me further into the depths of Your mystery! Pacify my soul! Make it Your heaven, Your beloved home and place of Your repose; let me never leave You there alone, but may I be ever attentive, ever alert in my faith, ever adoring and all given up to Your creative action.

O my beloved Christ, crucified for love, would that I might be for You a spouse of Your heart! I would anoint You with glory, I would love You – even unto death! Yet I sense my frailty and ask You to adorn me with Yourself; identify my soul with all the movements of Your soul, submerge me, overwhelm me, substitute Yourself in me that my life may become but a reflection of Your life. Come into me as Adorer, Redeemer and Savior.

O Eternal Word, Word of my God, would that I might spend my life listening to You, would that I might be fully receptive to learn all from You; in all darkness, all loneliness, all weakness, may I ever keep my eyes fixed on You and abide under Your great light; O my Beloved Star, fascinate me so that I may never be able to leave Your radiance.

O Consuming Fire, Spirit of Love, descend into my soul and make all in me as an incarnation of the Word, that I may be to Him a super-added humanity wherein He renews His mystery; and You O Father, bestow Yourself and bend down to Your little creature, seeing in her only Your beloved Son in whom You are well pleased.

O my 'Three,' my All, my Beatitude, infinite Solitude, Immensity in whom I lose myself, I give myself to You as a prey; bury Yourself in me that I may be buried in You so as to contemplate in Your light the abyss of Your Greatness! Amen. The Church of Saint John the Baptist invites you to
