My Dear Parishioners,


Today the Catholic Church commemorates the dramatic and important event of the first Pentecost, almost two thousand years ago, when the Holy Spirit descended on the Blessed Virgin Mary and the disciples assembled in prayer in Jerusalem, on the tenth day after the Ascension of Jesus Christ into Heaven. The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, the Spirit of Love. While all the activities of the Divinity in the world are actually performed by all three Persons, we ascribe or appropriate certain works to one particular Person. Hence, works of love, such as the enlightenment and the sanctification of human souls, we attribute to the Holy Spirit. For the same reason we attribute to the Holy Ghost the indwelling of God in the Church, which is a work of love.

On the first Pentecost the Holy Spirit became the very soul of Christ's Mystical Body, the Church. And just as the human soul gives to the body strength and vigor, so the Holy Spirit gives to the Catholic Church the power and the stability it needs to combat all hostile forces and to continue until the end of time its work of bringing souls to eternal salvation. St. Francis de Sales once commented, "The present which God gives to His Church on this Pentecost day must be considered as the most excellent, for what is given is love itself, for everyone ought to know that the Holy Ghost is the love of the Father and the Son."

Thank God for His protection over the Catholic Church and rejoice today in the birthday of the Church. Promise that you will so live your Catholic life that your soul will ever be worthy to be the dwelling place of the Holy Spirit.

The Carmelite Corner PENTECOST

V. Praised be Jesus Christ... R. Now and forever!

We Catholics think of Pentecost as a strictly Christian observance, but not so! Originally, Pentecost is a central feast of Judaism. Known as the Feast of Weeks, or שְׁבוּעוֹת [Shavuot] in Hebrew. Together, with אַכּוֹן [Pesach = Passover] and סְבוֹת [Sukkot = Feast of Tabernacles], it was one the three pilgrimage feasts of Israel during which each adult male was required to be present in Jerusalem (cf. Ex 23:14-17). Imagine St. Joseph taking the Child Jesus to Jerusalem three times a year from Nazareth, by foot, some roughly 100 miles. "Pentecost" is the rendering of this word from the Greek [Πεντηκοστή], meaning "fifty," since Shavuot occurs fifty days after the first day of Passover.

We have a first Lesson of today from Acts of the Apostles, and the timing of our Pentecost is directly tied to Shavout – this accounted for so many people, from all different nations, being in Jerusalem at the time. The Church of Jesus Christ receives its birth under the operation of the Holy Spirit – giving the strength of bold proclamation and clear understanding. The Church is under the guidance of the Holy Spirit – emboldening all Christians to proclaim a reliable message of salvation open to all the nations.

There is a wonderful tradition at the Church of Santa Maria Rotunda in Rome [formerly the Pantheon] on Pentecost, with this illustrated by a shower of rose petals from the oculus [the center hole in the roof to let in light]. Once a year, after the 10:30am Mass, petals fall from 144 feet (44 meters) above. The tradition of raining rose petals dates back to 609 A.D. under Pope Boniface IV, who dedicated this formerly pagan temple as a church in honor of the Virgin Mary and all martyrs. The falling petals symbolize the descent of the Holy Spirit at our first Catholic Pentecost.



OHM Teresa of Ávila had numerous mystical experiences and wished to share this with her Carmelite sisters. These, she knew, were informed by the power of the Holy Spirit, upon Whom we must call to progress in prayer and relationship with God. She invited her sisters, as she invites us, to connect continuously with the Paraclete.

Veni, Sancte Spiritus! Come, Holy Spirit! To Jesus Christ be all glory, alleluia!
